- → Once all components have been completed, submit all documents to the registration office at Pickens Technical College located in Building B.
- → Deadline for submitting completed applications:
 - Fall/August Entrance: First Monday of April
 - ◆ Spring/January Entrance: First Monday of October
- → Once applications have been reviewed, you will be notified of your status (Accepted, Waitlisted, Declined) via email within approximately 1 month of the deadline date.
 - Note: Applicants who are accepted into the Practical Nursing program are required to successfully pass a background check and drug screen.
